5 Tips to consider when choosing your Wedding Flowers

Simple designs using quality flowers can often work better than the most elaborate designs.

4) Bring the ceremony and reception areas to life!

This isn't any function - it's your wedding! Make your venues welcoming and personal.

By decorating the ceremony and reception areas, you will welcome your guests in style.

If you've opted for a church, then decorating the gable will distinguish your ceremony.

If you're on a budget, you could look at simple, personalised pedestals in the welcoming areas.

5) Get lots of opinions before you make your final choice
